Sample Itinerary 3 ARRIVING FROM CANBERRA

Day 1

- **11.00am** Arrive at the historic town of Nelligen. Visit Chapel on Clyde Craft Gallery and Devonshire Tearoom. Enjoy Devonshire Tea and a browse at the craft in this 100 year old restored church.
- **12noon** Depart Nelligen for Batemans Bay, stopping at The Oyster Shed for a Talk & Taste.
- **1.00pm** Travel south to Mogo for lunch at The Redgum Restaurant and wine tasting at Collina Winery.
- **3.00pm** Transfer to Old Mogo Town, an 1850s Goldrush theme park depicting the living history of Australian mining pioneers.
- **4.30pm** Board coach and travel back to Batemans Bay to check in for overnight accommodation and a rest before dinner.
- **6.00pm** Transfer to Catalina Country Club or one of Batemans Bay's restaurants for dinner.

Day 2

- 8.00am Breakfast at accommodation and check out.
- **9.15am** Board coach and travel south to Mogo Zoo, home to rare and endangered species. Enjoy morning tea at the zoo.
- **11.15am** Depart Mogo Zoo, travelling to Moruya along the picturesque coast road.
- **11.30am** A brief stop to view Moruya's historic buildings (from the coach), built from the same local granite used in the Sydney Harbour Bridge pylons.
- **12.30pm** Arrive at Trunketabella Gardens for a picnic lunch and guided tour of the gardens and rainforest.
- **3.00pm** Depart for Narooma.
- **3.30pm** Arrive at Narooma's Bar Rock Lookout, with spectacular views to Montague Island.
- **4.15pm** Check in to overnight accommodation at Narooma and rest before dinner.
- **6.00pm** Coach to Narooma Services Club, Narooma's Golf Club for evening meal, or try one of Narooma's restaurants.

Day 3

- 8.00am Breakfast at accommodation and check out.
- 9.15am Depart Narooma for Umbarra Cultural Centre at Wallaga Lake.
- **9.30am** Arrive at Umbarra and enjoy the morning learning about the region's indigenous history. Handson activities include boomerang and spear throwing, and painting with ochres. Morning tea at the coffee shop.
- **11.30am** depart for Central Tilba, where passengers have two hours to explore this National Trust village and have lunch.
- **1.30pm** Depart Central Tilba and commence return journey via Bega and Cooma.
