# Areas that dogs are prohibited from by legislation include:

- All National Parks and nature reserves, including Broulee Island, Congo, Bingi, South Head and Mystery Bay
- Wildlife Protection Area (NPWS)
- All council swimming pools, public halls, offices, play equipment and their environs
- Food preparation areas

# Dogs are also prohibited from the following beaches and adjacent reserves:

# A range of on the spot fines can be imposed by council for a variety of offences including:

- Animals not registered
- Dog without a collar
- Dog in a prohibited place
- Failure to remove dog faeces.

### **DOGS ON BEACHES**

The Council has rules in place to ensure dogs can be responsibly exercised on beaches in Eurobodalla. Most areas are available on a "time-share" basis between those with dogs and those who would rather be on the beach without dogs. There are some very popular swimming beaches where dogs are prohibited.

# **EXERCISE AREAS – TIME SHARE**

Time-share access is available on some beaches (check signage) and adjacent reserves and other reserves which are not prohibited by law, e.g. National Parks. Time-share access is available between 5pm-9am (1 Nov – 30 Apr) & 3pm-10am (1 May – 31 Oct.) Animals must be under effective control (leashed) until they are within the nominated off-leash areas.
